

The Bay 15 Race

Test & develop your team skills in the yacht racing world!

Design and Assembly



Participants are divided into teams and asked to design and assemble a Bay 15 (a 15 inch racing sailboat). The challenge is for team members to learn to subordinate individual goals for the team's goals—assembly goes MUCH smoother once this challenge is met. (duration 1 hour)



Bay 15 Regatta



Next, it's time for the teams to race their Bay 15 sailboats. The race begins from a starting line off shore. But there's a hitch! Participants may not touch their boats after placement in the water at the starting line. Team members can produce headway and direction for their boats by fanning, blowing, splashing or whatever means they have devised which does not involve touching the boat. The winning team receives a trophy. (duration 1 hour)
